He is involved in worldwide evangelism, teaching, and preaching. He conducts Israel & End-Time Prophecy Conferences, evangelism outreach missions' trips, missions' conferences, Israel Bible Study Tours, and revival meetings worldwide. He has authored several study courses and books, including *The Shulamite and the Shepherd* and *The Seven Feasts of the Lord*. Dr. Cook will provide instruction on Israel & End-Time Prophecy throughout our trip. You will be thrilled as we study God's Word on location! Never again will you open your Bible without seeing many of the sights we will see in Israel.



## DAY 1 – Monday, March 28 - ATLANTA, GA (Hartsfield-Jackson Atlanta Int'l. Airport)

Our group will depart from Atlanta Int'l. Airport (Atlanta, GA) aboard El Al Airlines (Israeli Airlines). We will fly El Al Airlines to New York City (JFK) making our connection for a non-stop flight to Tel Aviv, Israel.

## DAY 2 – Tuesday, March 29 - TEL AVIV, ISRAEL

We arrive in Tel Aviv, Israel where we will be met by our tour guide, transferred, and checked into the DAN PANORAMA HOTEL located on the Mediterranean Sea. We will enjoy dinner and have a brief meeting before retiring for the night. Tomorrow we will begin our "Journey of a Lifetime"!

## DAY 3 – Wednesday, March 30 - JAFFA / CAESAREA / MT. CARMEL / MEGIDDO

After breakfast, we begin our journey by driving to Jaffa, which affords us a breathtaking view of the city of Tel Aviv. At this picturesque port city of winding alleys, art galleries and crafts boutiques, King Solomon had the cedars of Lebanon rafted for the building of the First Temple in Jerusalem. You will view the spot of the House of Simon the Tanner. We drive north along the Plain of Sharon, the Mediterranean and the old coastal road – the Via Maris, which linked Egypt and Babylon as we journey towards Galilee. We stop at Caesarea, the incredible fortress city built by King Herod the Great. Here, Pontius Pilate had his base; where Cornelius lived and was baptized (Acts 10); where Paul embarked to Tarsus (Acts 9:30), and where Philip preached (Acts 8:40). Visit the Roman Theatre, the Hippodrome, and the Crusader City. We then travel north towards Haifa and ascend Mt. Carmel, the site where the prophet Elijah fought the 400 false prophets of Baal (1 Kings 18:30). We will stop for an incredible panoramic view of Haifa. We turn inland and proceed to Megiddo, one of King Solomon's walled fortified cities (1 Kings 9:15; 10:26), with ruins of 20 levels of civilization. From here the Books of Daniel and Revelation will come alive as we read about the Battle of Armageddon, while viewing the Plains of Jezreel. We then will continue to Tiberias and the Sea of Galilee. DINNER & OVERNIGHT AT EIN GEV HOTEL, TIBERIAS.

## DAY 4 – Thursday, March 31 - JESUS' MINISTRY IN GALILEE

After breakfast, we begin our day with a boat ride on the Sea of Galilee to Kibbutz Ginossar where we will see an ancient boat from the time of Jesus displayed at the Kibbutz Museum. We will continue to Capernaum, the center of Jesus' Galilean ministry and site of many of His miracles. We will see the remains of Peter's house and synagogue site where Jesus taught and worshipped. We will drive to Tabgha and visit the Church of Multiplication of Loaves and Fishes. Continue on to the Mt. of Beatitudes where Jesus delivered what is perhaps the most famous sermon ever preached – "The Sermon on the Mount" (Matthew 5). We then drive north of the Golan Heights and visit Banias, one of the sources of the Jordan River and the site of ancient Caesarea Philippi, where Peter made his confession of faith in Christ (Matthew 16:16). We then return via the east side of the Sea of Galilee stopping at Kursi to see the place where the demons entered the swine and entered the Sea of Galilee. DINNER & OVERNIGHT AT EIN GEV HOTEL, SEA OF GALILEE.

## DAY 5 – Friday, April 1 - ROAD TO JERUSALEM

We start the day with a visit to Yardenit, the Baptismal Centre on the Jordan River. Drive to Nazareth, the boyhood town of Jesus. We will visit Nazareth Village depicting a village from the time of Jesus. We continue southward to Beit She'an, where we will walk through the incredible excavations of the largest ongoing archaeological dig in the land of Israel with its Roman theatre, colonnaded Roman streets, mosaics and Roman bathhouses. It is also the city where the body of King Saul and his sons were nailed to the walls by the Philistines (1 Samuel 31:10). We then drive through the lush Jordan Valley, where the desert now blooms with flowers and vegetation of every description (Isaiah 35:12). Ascend up the Judean Wilderness to the Golden City of Jerusalem! DINNER & OVERNIGHT AT RAMET RACHEL HOTEL (JERUSALEM).



## DAY 6 – Saturday, April 2 -

### "WATCHMEN ON THE WALLS" PRAYER BREAKFAST / OLD CITY OF JERUSALEM

We will begin our day with a special prayer breakfast on behalf of Jerusalem and the Jewish people. We then drive to the top of the Mount of Olives for a panoramic view of the city of Jerusalem. Tracing the footsteps of Jesus, we will stroll down the Palm Sunday Route on the Mount of Olives to the Garden of Gethsemane, and the Church of All Nations. From here, we proceed by bus across the Kidron Valley, past the Tombs of Absalom, Zechariah, and James. We then proceed to Mt. Zion to visit the traditional site of the Upper Room (room of the Last Supper), King David's Tomb and the Church of St. Peter in Gallicantu, built on top of the High Priest Caiphas' house. We walk to the Zion Gate and enter the Old City of Jerusalem and walk through the Armenian Quarter to the Jewish Quarter. We will walk along the Roman/Byzantine street called the "Cardo" to the Western Wall, Judaism's holiest spot. We will view the Dome of the Rock and Al Aqsa Mosque on top of the Temple Mount. We continue our walk along the Via Dolorosa to see the Stations of the Cross, passing through the colorful bazaars, alleyways, and market places and reach the Church of the Holy Sepulchre for a brief visit. Walk through the Old City alleyways and exit from the Jaffa Gate where our bus will be waiting for us and end our day at the Garden Tomb for a private communion service in the garden for our group. DINNER & OVERNIGHT AT RAMET RACHEL HOTEL (JERUSALEM).

## DAY 7 – Sunday, April 3 - NEW CITY OF JERUSALEM

We start the day in the New City of Jerusalem by visiting Yad Vashem, Israel's memorial to the Holocaust commemorating the six million Jews that perished. Visit and walk through the newly opened Museum, visit the Children's Memorial, walk along the Avenue of the Righteous Gentiles for those that risked their lives to save Jewish lives. Continue to the Israel Museum and visit the Shrine of the Book housing the Dead Sea Scrolls, the oldest manuscripts of the Bible ever found. Visit the model of Jerusalem from the Second Temple Period as it looked from the time of Jesus. Drive to the Knesset, Israel's Parliament and take a picture of the large Menorah symbolizing the state of Israel. DINNER & OVERNIGHT AT RAMET RACHEL HOTEL (JERUSALEM).

## DAY 8 – Monday, April 4 - MASADA / QUMRAN / JERUSALEM

Today we drive to the lowest point on earth, the Dead Sea. We drive south along the shores of the Dead Sea to Masada. You will take a cable car to the summit of this magnificent fortress built by King Herod the Great and the last stronghold of the Jewish Zealots, walk around this historic ruins and see the palaces, bath houses, and a swimming pool. The oldest synagogue in the world is located on this mountain in the mid-dle of the desert. After descending this mountain by cable car, we continue north along the shores of the Dead Sea for a chance to “float” in the saltiest body of water in the world. Continue to Qumran for a visit where a young boy discovered the Dead Sea Scrolls in 1947 in the cave that you will see. These scrolls are the oldest scriptures of the Bible ever found. DINNER & OVER-NIGHT AT RAMET RACHEL HOTEL (JERUSALEM).

## DAY 9 – Tuesday, April 5 - JERUSALEM / TEL AVIV / DEPARTURE

Today is a day of leisure for shopping in the Old City bazaars or Jerusalem’s indoor shopping mall or just relax. We will have a late check-out of our hotel (1:00 pm), and then at 5:00 pm we will board our motor coach and drive to Tel Aviv. We will have a “Farewell Dinner” in a Middle-Eastern restaurant in Tel Aviv. After dinner we drive to Ben Gurion Airport for departure back to the United States.

## DAY 10 – Wednesday, April 6 - ATLANTA / HOME

We arrive in Atlanta, GA, in the morning hours, and then go to our perspective connecting flights to home.
